

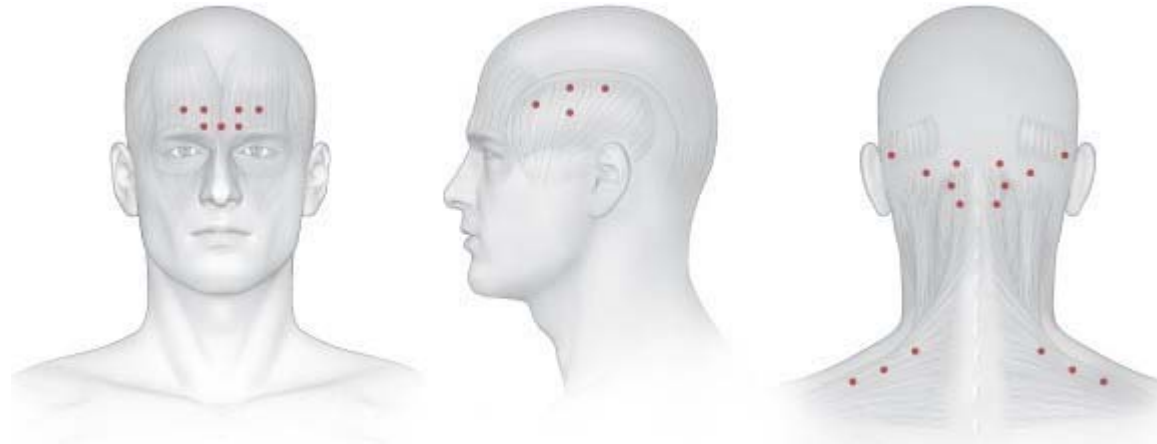
BOTOX INJECTIONS FOR MIGRAINES

What are Botox injections?

They are injections for people who suffer from chronic migraines to help prevent and reduce the amount of headaches experienced each month.

Where is Botox injected?

Your Physician will inject Botox into 31 injection sites in 7 specific areas in your head. (See chart below)



When should I consider Botox injections?

If you experience chronic migraines, 15 or more times per month that last 4-5 hours or more each time.

What is Botox?

It is a biologic medicine, made from a purified protein from a type of bacteria called Clostridium botulinum type A.



How often do I get Botox Injections?

Botox injections for chronic migraines are given every 12 weeks.
