

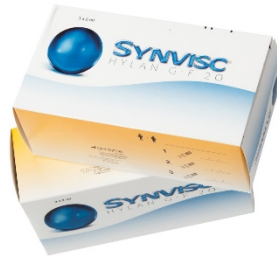
SYNVISC KNEE INJECTIONS

What is a Synvisc knee injection?

It is an injection done in the office by your physician and is placed directly in your knee joint.

What is Synvisc?

It is made up from a substance called Hyaluronan, which occurs naturally in your body and acts like a cushion and lubricant for your joints. Synvisc is a gel-like mixture of Hyaluronan which is made from chicken combs.

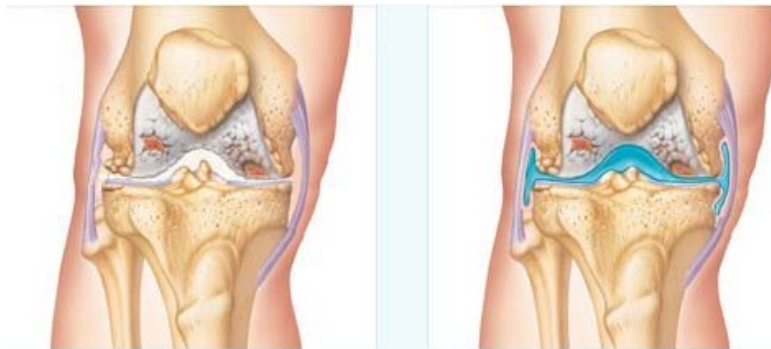


When would Synvisc be right for me?

If you suffer from osteoarthritis in your knee and you have tried other forms of treatment but are still experiencing pain.

How does it work?

It replaces the joint fluid that acts as a cushion for your knee which breaks down when you have osteoarthritis.



How long does it last?

The relief from a Synvisc injection can last up to 6 months.
